Client Management

- All Bedford County owned desktops and laptops must be connected to Bedford County client management system, Microsoft System Center Configuration Manager (SCCM).

Permissions

- Administrator privileges are not granted unless an exception has been provided and approved.

III. Software Licenses

Bedford County owned and licensed software can only be installed on Bedford County owned computers.

IV. IT Hardware Standards

- IT orders including a device with a hard drive must be approved by IT.
- Computers and IT equipment not owned by Bedford County are not supported
- Bedford IT does not support dual-boot partitions

V. Repairs

- Repairs are not performed on out-of-warranty computers or IT equipment

VI. Waiver / Exception Process

Requests for exceptions to policy will be considered and waivers from policy and standards granted only when appropriate risk management evaluation has been applied:

- Identification of why critical operational values cannot be achieved within the constraints of policy and standards; and
- Risk impact of the exception or waiver has been documented; and
- Alternatives that will achieve policy compliance have been reviewed in full and reasons why alternatives cannot be adopted are documented; and
- Compensating controls for the exceptions have been identified and implemented; and

The exception or waiver must be agreed to by Bedford County Information Technology Director.
